To be selected, participants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be between the ages of 14-22 at the time of the event
- 2. Entering 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade during the 2022 2023 school year (students in post-secondary programs such as 18+ are also strongly encouraged to apply)
