



5 Year Report for the Center on Disability and Development

Interdisciplinary Training

- 69 graduates in a leadership position.
- 357 of Postsecondary Access and Training in Human Services (PATHS) Certificate Program students and Graduate Students who have participated in Center projects.
- Over 149 training events.
- More than 7,564 hours spent training graduates and PSE students.
- 97% of UCEDD graduate and PSE students reporting an increase in knowledge or skills and/or a change of attitude.

Continuing Education

- 6,478 professionals participating in UCEDD Continuing Education programs.
- 33 UCEDD Continuing Education Programs.
- Over 9,029 total hours (course time) of Continuing Education program.

Community Services: Training

- Number of people trained
 - Education & Early Intervention: 9,383 (6,886 people with disabilities and family members)
 - Employment-Related Activities: 1,044 (235 people with disabilities and their family members)
 - Health-Related Activities: 1,722 (907 graduate students and post-secondary students)
 - Cultural Diversity: 118 (95 people with disabilities and their family members)
 - Quality of Life: 2,617 (650 people with disabilities and their family members)

Community Services: Technical Assistance

- 5,590 total number of hours of technical assistance provided in the areas of emphasis (Majority in Education and Early Intervention and Leadership).
- 82 total number of activities.
- 23,946 total number surveyed.
- 95% percent reported increase in enhanced resources, services, knowledge, strengthened networks, and capacity to assess current practices and policies.

Community Services: Model Services

- 134 specialised services offered by the UCEDD to enhance well cieng and status of recipient.
- 41,457 individuals who received specialized services from the UCEDD to enhance well-being and status of the recipient (Majority in Employment-Related and Quality Assurance categories).
